Lottery begins August 15, 2011 at 8:00 a.m. EDT and ends August 19, 2011 at 11:59 p.m. EDT

The CMHA HCVP provides rental assistance to help low-income persons afford privately-owned rental housing. Participants in the Program pay approximately 30% of their income to their landlord and CMHA pays the balance. CMHA HCVP participants may use their rental assistance anywhere in Cuyahoga County. Due to high demand for this assistance, the HCVP waiting list is usually closed.

CMHA, however, will open the waiting list soon by conducting a lottery. **Beginning Monday, August 15, 2011, at 8:00 a.m. through Friday, August 19, 2011, at 11:59 p.m.**, persons who are 18 years of age or older can submit entries **online at www.applycuyahogacounty.tenmast.com**, for a chance to obtain a place on the new waiting list. Seniors and persons with disabilities can contact the HCVP Waiting List Lottery Call Center at 800-223-4969 from 8:00 a.m. EDT through 8:00 p.m. EDT on the dates listed above for assistance with submitting an entry.

Lottery Information:

- Entries will only be accepted online. No paper lottery forms will be available.
- Entries will be accepted 24 hours-a-day while the waiting list is open.
- Entries can be submitted from any computer with internet access.
- Entrants will need their date of birth, social security number, address and general income information to complete the on-line lottery entry. It will also be helpful, although not necessary, to include the date of birth, social security number and income information for all other household members.
- Entrants should have a paper and pen handy when submitting their lottery entry to write down and keep the confirmation number that will be provided.
- Only one lottery entry will be accepted per person.
- There is no fee to enter the lottery.
- After the waiting list closes at midnight, August 20, 2011, the HCVP will conduct a random computer draw of 10,000 names from among all the entries received and place the selected names on the waiting list.
- The order in which entries are received will not affect a person's chance to be selected for the waiting list. The 1st person who applies has the same opportunity as the last person who applies.
- Entrants needing technical assistance with submitting an entry or having questions can contact the HCVP Waiting List Lottery Call Center at 800-223-4969 between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
- Entry into the lottery and placement on the waiting list do not guarantee the future award of a voucher. Persons placed on the waiting list will be determined eligible for the HCVP when their names reach the top of the waiting list.
