

Dear Resident,

This year, Parma celebrates its bicentennial. We will be reflecting on Parma's rich history and celebrating all that the city has to offer, including its beautiful parks and recreational amenities.

Throughout our 18 parks, we offer a variety of activities: roller hockey, disc golf, miniature golf, bocce, soccer, baseball, swimming, skating, tennis and pickleball. Our recreational leagues give youth and adults opportunities to compete in basketball, volleyball, soccer, softball and baseball. We also offer tennis, swimming and ice-skating lessons. At Michael A. Ries Park, our ice rink and four pickleball courts are popular attractions, and new playgrounds at Hetzel, John Petruska and Walters Grove parks keep children active.

Our Veterans Memorial Park is home to our Veterans Memorial, which includes monuments and pavers honoring those who fought for our country. The park also includes baseball/softball diamonds, a playground, exercise walking path, disc golf and miniature golf.

Our Anthony Zielinski Park attracts families to the Splash Pad and playground, hosts the new Rockin' at the Ridgewood Basin concerts and offers a selfie backdrop by the Parma sign and flamingo sculpture.

Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District has completed reconstruction of the basins at Zielinski and Veterans parks, improving stormwater management while also introducing accessible walking paths, native plants, interpretive boards and seating areas with scenic views.

The Ridgewood Golf Course had a banner year in 2025, celebrating its 100th anniversary and completing construction of the new Ridgewood Golf Club & Event Center, which is open to everyone, not just golfers. We expect this new facility to attract more visitors to our course and provide an inviting venue for meetings, events and special occasions. We're also excited about the new golf simulator room and Flamingo Pub.

I hope residents continue to frequent our parks and facilities, as well as use our new Golf Club & Event Center. In Parma, we have something for everyone to enjoy year-round.

I am a lifelong resident of the City of Parma and have worked in the Recreation Department for over 38 years. I have been fortunate to see our city firsthand continue to grow and flourish yet still hold its values, integrity, and sense of community. Through these years I have seen the importance our department has. I take great pride in knowing that we offer our residents the best in first-rate recreation while providing everyone with opportunities for exercise and enjoyment all year long.

The City of Parma Recreation Department offers some amazing activities that include, bocce ball, disc golf, a gaga pit, a warrior course, a manual batting cage, miniature golf, pickleball, swimming, and tennis. There are also health course exercise paths, outdoor fitness equipment, playground equipment, and an outdoor roller hockey court. Additionally, we have an indoor ice rink, a municipal golf course, soccer fields, ball fields, a splash pad and two outdoor swimming pools.

The long-awaited new Clubhouse/Event Center at the Ridgewood Municipal Golf Course is scheduled to open in March. It will include six new state-of-the-art simulators, an event center that can hold up to 200 guests which can divide into three separate rooms for smaller functions, a pub, patio, pro shop and a newly constructed pavilion. There are also artifacts of the history of the course displayed throughout the clubhouse.

As always, we encourage active participation and family enjoyment of the City of Parma's facilities, activities, and recreation programs.




